Level Records Demo Policy:

If you want us to listen to your material please make sure you have fully read this policy, and comply with it.

In general we are always interested in receiving new demo material, but we are NOT interested in receiving anything if you haven't at least listened to the previews of our past releases, and are aware of the kind of music we're releasing on Level Records.

So before you decide to send that demo, be sure the tracks fit our musical style.

Sending a lot of tracks will only increase the chance that we won't listen to all of them - just provide us with a selection of your strongest tracks.

We accept demos on CD-R or as MP3s. Tracks should be full versions, not just snippets. If you want to send us MP3s, bit-rate should be 128kbit or higher. Please put all the tracks together in one zip or rar-archive named . Please do not send us MP3s attached to emails. Instead, provide the archive for download on your own webspace or use a file-sending service, such as like yousendit.com or megaupload.com.

Notice: we don't like to register for a demo-download, so please make sure we can download without having to do so.

Please send us the Download-link to <contact (at) level-records.com> together with a brief introduction to yourself, including a list of your releases, if any.

If you prefer to send us a CD, please make sure your contact information and name is written on the CD itself.
